Notice of Hearing for the adoption of Regulations of the  
State of Nevada Board of Psychological Examiners

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.0603:

**1. The need for and the purpose of the proposed regulation or amendment.**

LCB File No. R192-24 (R192-24P): A REGULATION relating to psychologists; reestablishing certain provisions relating to the national examination for licensure as a psychologist; authorizing an applicant for licensure as a psychologist to begin to take the national examination before the conferral of a doctoral degree under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**2. If the proposed regulation(s) is a temporary regulation, either the terms or the substance of the regulations to be adopted, amended, or repealed, or a description of the subjects and issues involved. If the proposed regulation(s) is a permanent regulation, a statement explaining how to obtain the approved or revised text of the proposed regulation prepared by the Legislative Counsel pursuant to NRS 233B.063.**

A copy of the proposed regulations can be obtained on the Boards website by going to [www.psyexam.nv.gov](http://www.psyexam.nv.gov), or by contacting the Board of Psychological Examiners at 702-276-0926 or 3080 South Durango Drive, Suite 102, Las Vegas, NV 89117. A reasonable fee for copying may be charged.

**3. A statement identifying the methods used by the agency in determining the impact on a small business prepared pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS 233B.0608.**

A request for input regarding impact was posted and made available to the public and licensees of the Board of Psychological Examiners.

R192-24 (R192-24P): A workshop to present the proposed changes and hear public input on R192-24 was held on August 9, 2024.

**4. The estimated economic effect of the regulation on the business which it is to regulate and on the public. These must be stated separately and in each case must include:**

**(a) Both adverse and beneficial effects; and**

R192-24 (R192-24P): There should be no adverse effects to Psychologists in Nevada. The beneficial effects of the proposed revisions are intended to ensure clarity and consistency as it concerns the national exam requirements by reestablishing the national exam regulation that had previously been in place but had been inadvertently repealed.

**(b) Both immediate and long-term effects.**

Once the regulation revisions are approved and codified into NAC Chapter 641, the effects stated above will be immediate and long term.

**5. The estimated cost to the agency for enforcement of the proposed regulation.**

The Board does not believe there will be a cost for enforcement of the proposed revisions, as adherence to the regulation is part of the Board's normal course of business.

**6. A description of the citation to any regulations of other state or local governmental agencies which the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates and a statement explaining why the duplication or overlapping is necessary. If the proposed regulation overlaps or duplicates a federal regulation, the notice must include the name of the regulating federal agency.**

The Board is not aware of any overlapping or duplicating of federal or state regulations.
